Assessment districts for the year 1943 were set up as follows:

 Assessment Dist. No. 3 to be composed of School Dists. Nos. 2, 5, 6 and 7.
 Assessment Dist. No. 4 to be composed of School Dist. No. 9.

Pursuant to Chapter 115, Section 2309, of the 1931 Wyoming Revised Statutes a School Poll Tax of \$2.00 was levied by the Board on every person between the ages of 21 and 50 years.

As provided by law the Forest Reserve Fund was ordered distributed 80% to Roads and Bridges and 20% to general schools.

On motion regularly carried the Pinedale Roundup was designated the official county newspaper for the next two years.

Appointments to the County Welfare Board were: Mr. Nelse P. Christensen of Big Piney for a term of three years; Mr. James Jensen of Boulder for a term of two years.

On motion regularly made, seconded and carried the State Bank of Big Piney and the Rock Springs National Bank were approved as depositories for County funds not to exceed the amount of securities pledged respectively by them.

The County Clerk was regularly appointed as Custodian of the Court House and as County Purchasing Agent.

Mrs. Leona Lynn Pape, having indicated that she would not relinquish the room in the Court House used as the Superintendent's office, was formally requested to turn over the keys and to vacate the room formerly occupied by her. She refused to comply with the request. The Custodian of the Building was then instructed to request that she remove her personal property by the evening of the 5th. He was also instructed to have a new lock put on the door and to deliver the key to Mrs. Hockett.
