




Present were Donald W. Jewett, chairman, Milford B. Steele and Jake Pfisterer, Members: Absent. None:

SUBLINTE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION



Present were Donald W. Jewett, Chairman, Milford B. Steele and Jake Pfisterer, Members: Absent, none.


All additional schedules were checked with no changes being made to these.

All schedules which had been held for questioning were again reviewed and proper adjustments made.


There being no further business to be brought before the Board at this time, the meeting was adjourned for an indefinite time.
