June 4, 1963

The Board met on this date in regular session with all members present. The minutes of the previous meeting was approved as read. The reports of the various County Officers were approved and ordered filed. Having been advertised and no protests filed County Retail Beverage Permit No. 160 was granted to Keith C. Anderson and Mary Hill Anderson, Cora Store. The County Scholarships to the University of Wyoming were granted to Barbara Chapel, Big Piney, and Bonnie Burzlander, Pinedale. The following Acceptance Agreements were approved and money ordered turned into the County Treasury: No. 447, Cora Store, \$100.00; No. 4448, Town of Pinedale, \$50.00. The following bonds were approved: Robert W. Sievers, Clerk and Treasurer of the Town of Pinedale, \$2000.00; Winifred M. Peterson, Treasurer Town of Big Piney, \$1000.00. Approved was the special levy of 20 mills assessed on sheep for the control of predatory animals and an additional levy of 15 mills, for Year 1963. Pete Olson was appointed a member of the County Memorial Hospital Board for a term of five years. Max Boroff was appointed a member of the County Fair Board for a term of five years. Tharon Greenwood was appointed a member of the County Library Board for a term of three years.
