A regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, was held at the Commissioners Room, Sublette County Courthouse, the regular place of meeting of said Board, in Pinedale, Wyoming, on Tuesday, the 6th day of April, 1965 at the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M.

The Chairman of said Board called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present:

Thereupon Commissioners John Kvenild introduced the following Resolution which was thereupon read in full and is as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Sublette, County, Wyoming, deem it necessary and advisable for the County of Sublette, Wyoming, to construct and equip an addition to the existing Court House to be used as a courthouse and jail, in said County, and to submit to the qualified electors of the County the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of \$165,000 for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming further deem it necessary and advisable to construct and equip a county library and branch library in said County, the question of issuing bonds of such purpose in the principal amount of \$115,000, also to be submitted to the qualified electors of the County;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLINTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. That a special election to be held in Sublette County, Wyoming on Tuesday, the 11th day of May, 1965, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said County the questions and propositions more particularly described in the Notice hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. The election on the question of contracting bonded indebtedness of the County shall be held in those districts and precincts more particularly set forth in the Notice of Election, such districts and precincts being the same as those used at general elections in the County. The election shall be conducted and the results thereof canvassed and certified, in all respects as near as practicable, in the same manner as in general elections. On the day of said election the polls shall be opened at 9:00 o'clock A.M. and they shall be kept open without any adjournment until 7:00 o'clock P.M., at which time the polls shall be closed.

Section 3. At each polling place there shall be provided two ballot boxes, one to be designated Ballot Box "A" and the other Ballot Box "B". There shall also be provided two sets of ballots, one of which shall be printed on white paper and the other on colored paper, both of which shall contain the same statement of the questions to be voted upon and the same instructions respecting the manner of marking ballots..

If such elector is not the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment rolls of said County he shall be furnished by the officers conducting said election a ballot printed on white paper and the ballot of all such persons shall be deposited in Ballot Box "A".

If such elector is the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment rolls of said County he shall be furnished by such officers a ballot printed on colored paper, and the ballots of all such persons shall be deposited in Ballot Box "B".

Section 4. Every citizen of the United States of the age of 21 years and upwards, who has resided in the State of Wyoming one year, in the County of Sublette Sixty days, and in the election precinct wherein he seeks to vote ten days next preceding said election, and who has complied with the registration laws, shall be entitled to vote thereat, provided he appears in person at the polls on election day.

Before any person shall be permitted to vote as a property owner, he or she shall be required to make, before the officers of election, an affidavit showing that he or she is the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment rolls of said county.

Section 5. The official Ballot to be used at said election shall be in substantially the following form:
