OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS

Pinedale, Wyoming
May 14, 1968

The Board met in special session this date at 9:00 A.M. with Milford Steele, chairman, Jake Pfisterer, member, Robert M. Miller, member, Frank Allyn, Wyo. Highway Dept. Principal Right of Way Engineer, Cheyenne, Wyoming, John Ekern, Right of Way Agent, Wyo. Highway Dept., Cheyenne, Wyoming, Butler Hilton, Resident Engineer, Wyo. Highway Dept., Pinedale, Wyoming and Robert W. Evans, County Clerk, present.

Minutes of the May 7, 1968 meeting were read and approved with the following additions:
 (1) On motion regularly moved, seconded and carried, The State Bank of Big Piney and The First National Bank of Pinedale were approved as depositories for county funds not to exceed the amount of securities pledged.
 (2) The Board selected and appointed Ruth Ann Shepard of Big Piney, Wyoming and Nancy Steele of Pinedale, Wyoming to attend the University of Wyoming free of tuition for the school year 1968-1969. The presentations are to be made by representatives of the Board of County Commissioners at the commencement exercises of the respective schools.

The board instructed their clerk to write a letter to R.H. Shank, El Paso Natural Gas Co. to inquire into the availability of used pipe. It was moved by Jake Pfisterer and seconded by Robert M. Miller that the following resolution be adopted, motion carried. The board instructed John S. Mackey, Sublette County Attorney to prepare a Sublette County Commissioners Deed to John A. and Wilma H. Jones on Lots 13 and 14, Block 23, Marbleton.

The board also instructed their clerk to write a letter to the Wyoming Highway Dept. requesting that any overpayment made by Sublette County on road project No. SC-CFM-23-7 be deposited into State-County and County Farm-to-Market road funds.

The board requested John S. Mackey, Sublette County Attorney, to see what could be done with the special road fund money that is now on deposit at the First National Bank of Pinedale.

It was moved by Jake Pfisterer and seconded by Robert M. Miller that the following resolution be adopted, motion carried.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, deem the public interest required that a road be established to be known as the Cora North Road, Project S-1802(3)2, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south boundary of Section 4, T34N., R110W of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, from which the southeast corner thereof bears due east a distance of 38.5 feet;

thence running northwesterly a distance of approximately 7.5 miles across Section 4 in T34N., R110W., Sections 33, 28, 21, 20, 17, 8 and 5, T35N., R110W and Section 32, T36N., R110W of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, to a point of ending in Said Section 32 which point bears N. 15°36'W. a distance of 454.9 feet from a point which bears N. 13°23.4' W. a distance of 220.9 feet from a point on the south boundary of said Section 32 from which the southwest corner thereof bears S. 87°51' W. a distance of 660.0 feet.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the said Board do hereby initiate the procedure for the establishment of said road and declare their intention to establish said road by the following out of the provisions of Section 24-43 Wyoming Statutes, 1957, not inconsistent therewith.
