RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, deem it necessary and advisable for the County of Sublette, Wyoming, to construct and equip a building for use as a hospital in Pinedale, Wyoming, and to construct and equip a building for use as a diagnostic and treatment center in Big Piney, Wyoming, and to submit to the qualified electors of the County the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of \$300,000 for such purpose;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. That at the primary election to be held in Sublette County, Wyoming, on Tuesday, the 20th day of August, 1968, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said County the question and proposition more particularly described in the Notice and Ballot hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. The election on the question of contracting bonded indebtedness of the County shall be held in the same districts and precincts, at the same polling places, and shall be conducted by the same Judges and Clerks as shall be designated for the primary election and the vote shall be canvassed and returned and the result declared in the manner prescribed by law for other county elections.

On the day of said election the polls shall be opened at 9:00 o'clock A.M. and they shall be kept open without any adjournment until 7:00 o'clock P.M., at which time the polls shall be closed.

Section 3. At each polling place there shall be provided two ballot boxes, one to be designated Ballot Box "A" and the other Ballot Box "B". There shall also be provided two sets of ballots, one of which shall be printed on white paper and the other on colored paper, both of which shall contain the same statement of the question to be voted upon and the same instructions concerning the manner of marking ballots.

If such a elector is not the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment roll of said County, he shall be furnished by the officers conducting said election a ballot printed on white paper and the ballots of all such persons shall be deposited in Ballot Box "A".

If such elector is the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment roll of said County, he shall be furnished by such officers a ballot printed on colored paper, and the ballots of all such persons
