shall be deposited in Ballot Box "B".

Section 4. Every citizen of the United States of the age of 21 years and upwards, who has resided in the State of Wyoming one year, in the County of Sublette sixty days and in the Election Precinct wherein he seeks to vote ten days next preceding said election, and who has complied with the registration laws, shall be entitled to vote thereat, provided he appears in person at the polls on election day.

Before any person shall be permitted to vote as a property owner, he or she shall be required to make, before the officers of election, an affidavit showing that he or she is the owner of or the spouse of the owner of real or personal property assessed on the assessment rolls of said County.

Section 5. The official Ballot to be used at said election shall be in substantially the following form:

THE ELECTOR SHALL PREPARE HIS BALLOT BY MARKING A CROSS (X) IN THE SQUARE OPPOSITE THE WORDS WHICH EXPRESS HIS VOTE.

QUESTION SUBMITTED:

"Shall the County of Sublette, Wyoming, be authorized to issue General obligation Hospital Bonds of said County in the principal amount of \$300,000 bearing interest at a rate or rates not exceeding the maximum rate of 6% per annum allowed by statute, payable semi-annually, maturing serially within 20 years from their date, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a building for use as a hospital in Pinedale, Wyoming, and for constructing and equipping a building for use as a diagnostic and treatment center in Big Piney, Wyoming?"

Section 6. The Board of County Commissioners is hereby directed and authorized to issue a Notice and Proclamation, not sooner than 25 days and not less than 15 days before the date of election, which Notice and Proclamation shall be published in the Pinedale Roundup and the Big Piney Examiner, newspapers of general circulation in the County, setting forth the fact that on Tuesday, the 20th day of August, 1968, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the County the question and proposition hereinbefore set forth.

In addition to the publications set forth above, said Notice and Proclamation shall be published additionally once in each newspaper on the last day upon which such newspaper is published before said special election.

Section 7. The Notice and Proclamation shall be signed by the Chairman and attested by the Clerk of said Board of County Commissioners and shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, Chapter 5, Article 3, Wyoming Statutes 1957, as amended, and Title 18, Chapter 9, Wyoming Statutes 1957, at the Primary Election to be held in the several election districts and polling precincts in the County of Sublette, on Tuesday, the 20th day of August, 1968, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said County, the following question and proposition:

"Shall the County of Sublette, Wyoming, be authorized to issue General Obligation Hospital Bonds of said County in the principal amount of \$300,000 bearing interest at a rate or rates not exceeding the maximum rate of 6% per annum allowed by statute, payable semi-annually, maturing serially within 20 years from their date, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a building for use as a hospital in Pinedale, Wyoming, and for constructing and equipping a building for use as a diagnostic and treatment center in Big Piney, Wyoming?"

The election on the above question shall be held at the same election districts, precincts and polling places as designated for the Primary Election to be held on the same day.

The polls shall be opened at 9:00 o'clock A.M. and shall be kept open without any adjournment until 7:00 o'clock P.M., at which time said polls shall be closed.
