OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

Pinedale, Wyoming  
August 3, 1971

Board met regular session this date with Paul C. Hagenstein, Chairman and Michael Marincic present.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and Michael Marincic moved they be approved as read seconded by Paul C. Hagenstein, and carried.
