OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

February 6, 1973
Pinedale, Wyoming

The Board met in Regular Session on this date with all members present.
The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.
The monthly reports of the following Officials were approved and ordered filed in the County Clerk's Office. Hazel P. Bloom, Clerk of Court, Aune R. Clark, County Clerk, Paul Ziegler, Justice of Peace of Pinedale, Robert L. McFarland, Sheriff.
The following Bond was approved and ordered filed in the County Clerk's Office; Richard W. Kape, Deputy Sheriff, \$1,000.00.
The County Commissioners suggested to Mr. Walker and Mr. Mariner that a meeting be held of all people involved in the proposed alley way between their two pieces of property in Cooley First addition to Pinedale and see if the this project was feasible.
Mr. Marvin T. Kolstad, Department of Agriculture, Food Stamp representative out of Riverton was in to discuss various problems around the Food Stamp program and other Welfare issues.
Mr. Spencer Garret, Highway Department Planning Division, discussed all forms of transportation, but mostly 95% of Highway. Various road classifiactions were discussed with very few changes made on previous classifications.
The mayor of Big Piney, Paul N. Scherbel and two Councilmen, the Mayor of Pinedale Jay CcClain and one Councilman, the Mayor of Marbleton all met with the County Commissioners on their Solid Waste problems, after much discussion it was agreed that Big Piney, Pinedale and Marbleton haul their Solid Wast material to the Day Daniel Dump Grounds for a trial run and if at all feasible for one year to find out what the Cost of Hauling and the County to find out what the Cost of covering would be, and then perhaps more concrete figures could be seen to continue or to do something else.
Paul Scherbel and the County Commissioners talked about the Scab Creek Road and Dell Creek Road. Each road needed more work on Platts and rights-of-ways.
Connie Avey, County Health Nurse and the Commissioners discussed next years budget figures and County Employees vacations and sick leave.
Ed Kaumo of Rock Springs wanted to know what could be done about his Zone Change request and the possiblity of a Variance issued for his Trailer presently located at Boulder. The County Commissioners will take this issue under advisement and find a satisfactory answer to all existing problems.
