




OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

February 11, 1974
Pinedale, Wyoming

The Board met inbSpecial Session with all members present and Thomas Muths, Jackson Wyo., Stan Wenigar, Mayor of Pinedale; Councilmen of the Town of Pinedale, Bob Sweedler and Paul Hanson; School Board Members, A.L. Korfanta Dr. J. Thomas Johnston, A. Gosar; Superintendent of School, Spike Jorgenson; Principal of the Grade School Mr. Loren H. Denney.

Mr. Muths gave a thumb-nail sketch of what the County would like to do with the ramp and drive way for the proposed County Jail, however, there wasn't too much enthusiasm by the City Fathers to allow the County 25 ' of the Mill Street for this purpose. Therefore, after some discussion, Mr. Jake Pfisterer thought it would be better to keep all of the ramp and drive way on county property. The meeting broke up about 1:30, and the Commissioners continued to the Commissioners' office for more discussion and planning of the jail needs.

Discussions on various matters ensued, but no definite plans on any of them.
Paul Hagenstein adjourned the meeting at 5:30 on his motion.
