

Charles McCarty of Sublette Communications, submitted a proposal to furnish and maintain county radio equipment. This proposal is being considered by the County Commissioners along with the proposal submitted by the Motorola representative.

A plat indicating standard grading sections was approved and adopted by the Board as minimum requirements for roads in Sublette County.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, Bill Wills was appointed to the T.V. Advisory Committee to represent the Bondurant area.

On motion duly made by Lois Cobb, seconded by Bill Alexander and carried unanimously, the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County deem the public interest requires that a road be established to be known as FAVAZZO SUBDIVISION COUNTY ROAD NO. 23-199 in accordance with Section 24-50, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended, generally described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point within the right-of-way of the Fremont Lake County Road No. 23-154, N89°-57'W, 713.1 feet, thence S41°-20'W, 2727.8 feet from the northeast corner of Section 34, T34N, R109W, Sublette County, Wyoming; thence running Easterly through the SW¼SE¼ of said Section 34 to an intersection with Moose Street and Big Horn Drive on the west line of Favazzo Subdivision; thence along Elk Drive, Antelope Street, Big Horn Drive and Moose Street only of the said Favazzo Subdivision; WHEREAS, the roads within the Favazzo Subdivision are dedicated to the use of the public on the official plat of the Favazzo Subdivision of record in the Office of the Clerk of Sublette County in Book 26 of Miscellaneous Records on page 469;

WHEREAS, the lands in the said SW¼SE¼ are included in that easement of record in the said Office in Book 26 of Miscellaneous on page 365;

WHEREAS, the road has been constructed to standards of the County at no expense to the County;

WHEREAS, the official linen plat for this road is filed in the Office of the Clerk of Sublette County;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FAVAZZO SUBDIVISION COUNTY ROAD NO. 23-199 as described above, be and is hereby declared established a public county road.
