

SUBLETTE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The first meeting of the County Board of Equalization for 1978 was held in the Commissioner's room of the county court house commencing at 9:00 O'clock on Monday May 22, 1978.

Present were C. F. "Bill" Alexander and Lois Cobb, commissioners, and Hazel Werner, County Assessor, acting as clerk of the Board. Absent was Robert V. Thompson, commissioner.

Mr. and Mrs. John Yenko, Sr. of Rock Springs, Wyoming, appeared before the Board to protest the taxes on their properties in the Gypsum Creek Subdivision as being out of proportion with other taxes being paid by their neighbors. The schedules were checked over with no reduction in valuation being made.

Mrs. Eloise Snow was in to appeal the tax valuations on her residence at the Hoback Ranches subdivision. The valuations which were listed were deemed to be in line with other like properties and no change was made.

The Board discussed the agricultural land re-evaluation program which will be undertaken later this summer. No contract will be issued until further consideration can be given the firms giving quotations on this project.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting was recessed until 9:00 O'clock A.M. of June 12.
