


OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

Pinedale, Wyoming  
November 14, 1978

The Board of County Commissioner met in regular session this date at 9:00 A.M. Present: Chairman Robert Thompson, Members C. F. Alexander and Lois E Cobb and Clerk Lois J. Yake. Commissioner Elect Bob Tanner was also present during the afternoon.

Reduction Orders approved: Theodore L & Jane J Eastmond, \$6.83; Jasper A & Betty J Hobgood, \$164.75; Alfred H & Ann T Walker, \$30.18; Frank & Francine F Favazzo, \$28.50; John Amos, \$351.24 and Antonio & Dorothy Corona, \$26.72.

Low bid of \$6,069.00 received of Anderson-Penton Chev. Co., on a 1979 2-wheel drive pickup for the Road & Bridge Dept. was accepted on motion by Alexander. Motion seconded by Cobb and carried. One other bid was received of Walton Ford for \$6,298.43.

Letter of resignation submitted by Paul Refior, as attorney appointed for the enforcement of county zoning and subdivision resolution was approved at this time.

Because the only eligible person to file for Justice of the Peace failed to achieve a majority vote the commissioners are required to fill this position by appointment on or before December 1. Applications for appointment to this office will be received until November 27 and prospective justices of the peace will be interviewed by the Commissioners and District Judge before an announcement is made. An appointment for the Justice of the Peace having an office in Big Piney will also be made at this time since the present appointee's term expires at the end of this year.

Letter of resignation submitted by Renee Joy, County Extension Agent, effective November 30, 1978 was accepted.

Transfer of county Retail Liquor License from Pat Wade dba Elkhorn Stores to M/N, Inc. dba Elkhorn Stores was approved on motion duly made seconded and carried.

Request of Jim Barger and Howard Earles, on behalf of the Sublette County Racing Assoc., that the county plow the track before cutter races was denied.

Thompson made a motion, seconded by Alexander, that the County commence abandonment procedures on the upper portion of the North-Piney-Cottonwood Road #23-143, from the old Guthrie place to the forestboundary. Voting aye: Thompson and Alexander. Voting nay: Cobb. Motion carried.

Motion by Alexander that the county commence abandonment procedures on the Sommers Road #23-146 was seconded by Cobb. All voted aye, motion carried.

Request of Lois Koch, Hospital Board member, that the county remove snow from the parking area of the new Medical Center was approved since the County owns the property. The county will advertise the old D & T Center in Pinedale, as is, for sale to the highest bidder. Building to be removed from county property.

Public hearing for zoning amendment requested by Allen E. and Deanne Bradley, to reclassify 8 acres from A-1 to I-L, being the north 8 acres of the NE¼SW¼, Sec. 20, T30N, R11W, lying and being situate easterly of the centerline of State Highway 189. Cobb moved that, as the Town of Marbleton had no objections, the zoning amendment be accepted as recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission. Alexander seconded.
