OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

Pinedale, Wyoming
February 6, 1979

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. Present: C. F. Alexander, Chairman, Lois E. Cobb and W. R. Tanner, Members and Lois J. Yake, Clerk.

Minutes of January meetings were approved as published.

Tax Reduction Order for Ronald O. Rees was approved for \$44.16.

Bonds approved and ordered filed: Jean B. Risser, Clerk-Treas., Town of Pinedale, \$2,000.00; Richard W. Kape, Floyd E. Oxner and Robert J. Hanson, Deputy Sheriffs, \$1,000.00 each.

Bette Thompson was appointed to the Sublette County Library Board to fulfill the unexpired term of Maicille Carr who has resigned due to numerous other commitments. Said term will expire June 30, 1981.

Gene Schrader, Executive Secretary to the Criminal Justice System Planning Committee, Sheriff Bud Slatter and Paul Hagenstein reported progress in the change over from low band to high band radio equipment to improve the communication system of law enforcement agencies statewide. A grant application for matching federal and state funds to help finance the project was signed by the Commissioners. Bid specifications have been prepared by the Criminal Justice Planning Committee and should be let sometime in March.

Joe Hicks of Redstone Corp. and Fred Wyatt and Bob Cordell of the Bureau of Land Management met with the Board about roads in the Restone New Fork River Subdivision. Redsonite Corp. has applied for a right-of-way easement from the BLM to provide legal access to lot 17 as required by the Commissioners prior to approval of this lot. Motion by Bob Tanner that the county accept the Redstone New Fork River Road within the subdivision providing that Mr. Hicks is successful in obtaining the right-of-way from BLM and that the road is completed to county standards. There will be no county maintenance until such time as the Commissioners feel it is warranted. Motion seconded by Lois Cobb and carried.

The Commissioners approved the subdivision plat of Daniel Meadows Commercial Lots.

The following resolution was adopted on motion by Bob Tanner, seconded by Lois Cobb and carried:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners, Sublette County, Wyoming, deem the public interest requires that a road be established to be known as the Greenwood County Road No. 23-200, described as follows:

Commencing at Station 0+00 on the East right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 189, N68°-22'W, 2385.3 feet from the E½ corner of Sec. 28, T31N, R111W, 6th P.M., Sublette County, Wyoming;

Thence running easterly through the following:

T31N, R111W,

Section 28 - S½NE½

Section 27 - SW½NW½, NW½SW½, NE½SW½

and terminating at Station 40+90.7 identical with Station 107+76.5 of the Muddy Creek County Road No. 23-177.

all in accordance with the official map of said road of record in the Office of the Clerk of Sublette County.

WHEREAS, right-of-way easement has been secured from Bar Flying V Ranch Company as owner of the only patented lands, and whereas, a right-of-way has been obtained from the Bureau of Land Management serial number W-0317601 for all other lands and is of record in the Office of the Clerk of Sublette County in Book 28 of Miscellaneous on page 67 being an affidavit prepared by Paul N. Scherbel, Surveyor on April 6, 1964.
