

Hugh Caton, President of the First National Bank of Pinedale and Donald Wassenser, President of the State Bank of Big Piney were present to negotiate an interest rate for county money. Mr. Caton stated that the interest rate for state funds is set semi-annually by the State Board of Deposits and is currently set at 8 3/4 per cent and they offered the same rate to the county. The Commissioners found this rate to be satisfactory and the two banks were designated as depositories for county funds for the ensuing year.

County Extension Agent Eric Peterson expressed interest in having Sublette County tied in to a computer bank program which provides numerous programs to aid agriculture. This program serves five states and fifteen Wyoming counties are presently signed up for these services. The cost would be approximately \$75. to \$80. per month. The Board asked him to determine the number of ranchers who would actually use the services if they are made available.

Motion was made by Cobb, seconded by Tanner and carried that revised resolutions be adopted for the following roads to correct discrepancies contained in the original resolutions:

County Attorney Robert Sievers was asked to write to the Town of Pinedale and the Hospital Board to convey the Commissioners willingness to accept the access road to the Favazzo Subdivision as a county road if the town and hospital board will grant the necessary easements to the county. In return the county will assign its R/W easement, for the Tyler Avenue Extension which is now within the town limits, to the Town of Pinedale.

Jim Smith, accompanied by his wife Alfreda, inquired about his claim for damages submitted by county voucher in January. The Commissioners stated that no action will be taken on this claim until he has provided the itemized information requested of him via letter from the county attorney. Mr. Smith said he had misplaced the letter and was given a copy. Mr. Smith then informed the Commissioners that the county was in violation of a federal law because the catalytic converter has been removed from the county pickup driven by Road & Bridge foreman Dick Evans. Mr. Smith also stressed the need for a cattleguard on county road 23-200 to prevent livestock from getting out and causing an accident. The Commissioners agreed and will construct a gate at that point until weather permits the installation of a cattleguard.
