

## Official County Commissioners' Proceedings continued... January 6, 1981

Pinedale Mayor Bob Sweedler attended the meeting to discuss town and county business. He stated that the town council has decided to table the contract whereby the county would be required to pay a fee for use of the town's septage treatment and sewer disposal service until they receive the final report on a study being conducted by Tudor Engineering. He thought that the present pit at the sanitary landfill would suffice until spring and that the county will probably be approached about digging a new pit at that time. He stated that the town has requested a financial report which should be received in January and that they are scheduled to meet, on Thursday, with a local man who wants to lease the airport.

Water Commissioner Chuck MacIlvaine told the Board that they have a lot of problems with subdivisions containing water rights and are trying to get a bill introduced into this legislative session to alleviate some of the problems. He felt that subdividers should be made aware of these problems and either relinquish the water right prior to subdividing or spell out the lot owners rights to irrigation water on the subdivision plat if the water rights are to go with the land.

Zoning amendment application by Joseph and Rebecca Sondgeroth, Michael and Marlene McFadden, agents, to reclassify 10.52 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 19, T33N, R108W from A-1 to R-R use, was approved on motion by Floyd Bousman with the stipulation that the deed will contain a restriction against further division of the land. Motion seconded by Bob Tanner and carried.

Zoning amendment application by Robert B. and Rosemary Wells to reclassify 10 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 33, T38N, R113W, from A-1 to R-R, use was approved on motion by Bob Tanner, seconded by Floyd Bousman and carried.

In accordance with Nomination Petitions received, Gary Espenschied, Vernon Mrak and Edward F. Steele, Jr. were appointed to four year terms as Pinedale area Directors of the Sublette County Weed and Pest Control District on motion by Bob Tanner. Motion seconded by Floyd Bousman and carried.

A proposal by Main, Hurdman and Cranstoun to assist county offices in converting to a modified accrual basis of accounting, by July 1, 1981 as required by statutes, was accepted on motion by Bob Tanner. Motion seconded by Floyd Bousman and carried. Under the proposal the CPA firm will provide services and record keeping materials at a cost not to exceed \$2,000.00

A contract, submitted by Chuck McCarty dba Sublette Communications, to provide maintenance for all county owned and leased radio equipment, was accepted and signed by the commissioners.
