Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, be authorized to issue general obligation bonds of the County in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$1,500,000 for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new county courthouse together with incidental improvements, the bonds to bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed ____% per annum, to mature within not exceeding ____ years from their date or dates and to be issued and sold on such lawful terms and conditions as the Board may determine, including provisions for the redemption of bonds prior to their respective maturities at or above par?

Section 4. The special bond election shall be held in the manner prescribed by the Wyoming Election Code of 1973.

Section 5. The Special Bond Election Precinct and District Number and polling place shall be as follows:

Section 6. The election officials to submit the question shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners in the manner provided by law. The election officials before beginning their duties shall severally take and subscribe an oath in writing in substantially the following form:

"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will impartially and to the best of my knowledge and ability perform the duties of my office. I will studiously endeavor to prevent all frauds, deceit and abuse in the application of the election laws of this state."

Such oath shall be taken before a judge of election.
