
The sealed bids were opened and read aloud by Commissioner Tomassi as follows:



OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Pinedale, Wyoming
January 17, 1984

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with members Floyd E. Bousman, Gordon Johnston and Louie Tomassi and County Clerk Lois Yake present.

Minutes of the previous regular and intervening special meeting were read. There being no corrections or additions the minutes were accepted and filed as read.

As authorized by state statutes the county commissioners designated the following dates when county liquor licensees may operate their dispensing rooms for a period of 24 hours from their regular opening time:

May 27 - Memorial Day week-end
July 8 - Rendezvous

June 24 - Bondurant Barbeque
Sept 2 - Labor Day week-end

On motion by Commissioner Johnston, seconded by Commissioner Tomassi the Board adopted Resolution No. 84-63B authorizing the lease purchase of a John Deere crawler tractor and accessories, and directing the chairman to execute a lease-purchase agreement.
