NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

- 1. That the terms of Resolution No. 84-109B, in so far as the same are not in conflict with the terms of this resolution are hereby ratified, adopted and confirmed, namely, that there is hereby declared to be established and adopted a county court system for Sublette County, Wyoming, consisting of one county judge sitting in Pinedale, and in the Big Piney-Marbleton area as required.
- 2. That the county court system for this county shall become effective and operational on July 1, 1985.
- 3. That funding for the operation and maintenance of the county court system shall be as provided by statute.
- 4. That the court shall be called the "County Court of Sublette County, Wyoming."
- 5. That the justice of the peace courts of Sublette County shall be supplanted and replaced by the county court system on July 1, 1985.

Exxon Company has allocated \$25,000.00 to allow the county to hire a county planner, for three months, to develop impact strategy and to inventory existing data including the status of Exxon's potential commitment to the county. After interviewing individuals and planning firms submitting applications for the job the county commissioners hired BRW, Inc. at a cost of \$15,000.00. The planning firm will review existing county and town ordinances, local and state studies, and Exxon's permit applications affecting the county's expenditures and environmental impacts. They will also meet with community officials, agencies, businesses and town councils to discuss anticipated impacts and draw up a strategy to mitigate Exxon's effects upon the county. The commissioners reserved for themselves the responsibility to negotiate with Exxon Company for financial relief to mitigate impact.

Kay Jensen was appointed to the Planning and Zoning Commission to fulfill the unexpired term of Muriel Chidsey who resigned.
