

From US Highway 191 to Sublette County Road No. 23-123 - Mr. Noble recommended that this road be dedicated as a county road. Again any additional gravel required to bring it up to county road standards would be the developers responsibility.

Roads within the Scenic View Subdivision - Mr. Noble recommended that these not be accepted into the county road system because he feels that home owners should be responsible for maintenance of subdivision roads to their personal property.

The Board agreed with Mr. Noble's recommendations for the Scenic View Subdivision roads and for Agate Street to Granite Lane but feel that there is not sufficient population on the road from US 191 south to Stone Lane to justify county maintenance at the present time.

The County Commissioners then agreed that the county will accept Agate Street to Granite Lane and from that point east to County Road 23-123 upon receipt of the proper easements and when it can be determined that the roads are graveled to meet county standards.

The Boulder volunteer fire department was recently organized as a non-profit organization known as the Boulder Volunteer Fire Company for the purpose of contracting fire protection with the county. Members John Blaha, Lars Michnevich and Jerry Jensen were present to execute the contract and to transfer ownership of property owned, now owned, or hereafter acquired to Sublette County.

Having been published in the Pinedale Roundup on December 31, 1985, public hearing was held for the following:
