

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That each County Commissioner, with an effective term commencing January 5, 1987 and ending January 1, 1991, shall receive \$6,000.00 annually. In addition each County Commissioner shall receive \$50.00 for each meeting in excess of the two regularly scheduled monthly meetings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the salaries herein established shall not be changed during the four-year term of said elective officers.

At the request of Dan Holgate, John Linn and Scott Mackie, the County Commissioners agreed to allocate \$12,000. for the purchase of four dry suits and related equipment and \$4,000. for training for the purpose of establishing a county SCUBA team. The diving team will be used to conduct underwater search and rescue operations throughout the county.

Big Piney Mayor Dick Holgate told the County Commissioners that he is opposed to having the ambulances moved from the Big Piney town fire hall to Marbleton "when and if" a new facility is constructed in Marbleton. He said that Don Pope handles 80 percent of the calls that pertain to Piney's senior citizens in the past three to four years and as an employee of the town, is readily available to respond to calls. He stated that he had met with the hospital board last week and they were in favor of keeping them in Big Piney also. The County Commissioners will give this matter further consideration although they have already agreed to provide \$100,000. towards the construction of a new ambulance-fire hall in Marbleton.

Having been published in the Pinedale Roundup on May 1, 1986, public hearing was held for the following:
