A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HOWARD M. KNUTSON AND THOMAS A. GILBERTSON FOR A ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY CHANGE TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 18 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM AGRICULTURAL (A-1) DISTRICT TO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL (I-L) DISTRICT BEING PART OF THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ AND N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 19 AND PART OF THE S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 18, T29N, R111W, SUBLINTE COUNTY, WYOMING.

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS June 3, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session this date with Commissioners Gordon Johnston, Louie Tomassi and Floyd Bousman and County Clerk Lois Yake present.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Johnston. The minutes of the preceding regular meeting were accepted as written on motion by Commissioner Tomassi. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bousman and carried.

Sealed bids for the construction of an equipment storage garage at Bondurant were opened and read aloud as follows:

Don Driggs Construction - Building without insulation and sheetrock with R-38 in attic and R-19 in walls and 5/8' sheetrock, fire taped throughout	\$37,427.16
Custom Construction-Western Pioneer Homes - Building as per specs	\$43,172.00
	\$29,800.00

Each bid was accompanied by the required ten (10) percent bid bond and after determining that the specifications included insulation of the sidewalls and roof, Commissioner Bousman moved to accept the low bid subject to review by the County Attorney to insure that it met the bid requirements. Motion seconded by Commissioner Tomassi and carried.

Search and Rescue Commanders, Tom Fields of the Tip Top unit and Dean Grossman of the Pinedale unit, presented budget requests of \$43,000. and \$11,900. respectively for FY'87.
