requested that the sale be pursued, excluding the purchase of the existing cells. The Sommers project is waiting for signatures. Hiner informed the Board that the Coordinated Activity Plan will be available within the next three weeks and suggested that a local member be appointed by the Board to serve on this committee. The placement of rocks around the Fremont Lake Lookout was discussed.

The Sublette Citizens for Recycling discussed their proposal for initiating recycling at the Pinedale Landfill. Fifteen citizens were in attendance. Use of volunteers, the construction of a moveable, protective structure, community training, insurance and expansion into the Big Piney area was discussed. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to make the \$5,000, presently budgeted for recycling in the County FY92 budget, available to the group for development of the Pinedale program. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Skinner and seconded by Commissioner Wassenberg to cancel the next regular meeting scheduled for September 17th due to the Wyoming Association of County Officials (WACO) meetings in Sheridan that week. The motion carried.

Sheriff Jack Cain discussed salaries for secretarial staff with the Board and was again reminded that starting salary is \$1075 per month for these positions. Cain informed the Board that he had no objection to School District #9 using the Hogsback location for communications.

It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to award the vehicle bids opened at the August 27th meeting to the following: 3/4 ton 4 wheel drive pickup, E&L Motors for \$14,002.21; light duty 4 wheel drive pickup, Frontier Ford & Mercury for \$14,980; and mini-van, Frontier Ford & Mercury for \$16,667. The motion carried.

The lot division plat for Half Moon Lot Division was signed.

The Board conducted interviews for the Civil Defense Coordinator position. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to offer the position to James Highley. The motion carried.

Jeff Alexander of Sublette Communications and Dr. Ron Luty, Superintendent of School District #9, discussed accessing the Hogsback for radio communication. The Board approved the access.

Bob Maxam and Ridge Larson of the Pinedale Volunteer Fire Department, and Skip Young and Dan Smith of Plan One Architects, presented the plans for the Pinedale Fire Hall. The cost for construction is estimated at \$720,000. The Fire Hall will be located on the east half of the old elementary school site. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to adopt Resolution No. 91-316C authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to make application for Mineral Royalty Grant Funds. The motion carried.

The Board designated September 30, 1991, as the last day for application for the Retail Liquor License made available by increased County population. The final hearing for issuance will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 1991, at 1 p.m. The County Clerk was directed to make public notice of this information.

It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to adopt Resolution No. 91-318C forbidding smoking in the Sublette County Courthouse and Sheriff's Office and Jail and Resolution No. 91-319C requiring testing of well and surface water in commercial establishments. The motion carried.

Miriam Carlson, Mayor of Pinedale, Dave Hohl and Rose Skinner, Pinedale Town Councilpersons, and Sheriff Jack Cain discussed the law enforcement contract and lack of coverage provided. After lengthy discussion, it was determined that a joint committee on law enforcement might be appropriate and that budget considerations need to be addressed early.
