

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
SEPTEMBER 15, 1992

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on this date at 1:00 p.m. with Craig Crandall, Monte Skinner, Buzz Wassenberg, Mike McGinnis, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The minutes of the preceding meeting of September 1, 1992, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Skinner and seconded by Commissioner Wassenberg. The motion carried.

In accordance with the public notice published in the Pinedale Roundup on August 27, 1992, public hearing was held for the following:

1. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to approve the final plat for Middle Butte Estates Subdivision. The motion carried and the plat was signed.

2. Request by Leon Hirsch to amend the conditional use permit for a 7,500 foot runway located on the Antelope Run Ranch granted on May 21, 1991. It was moved by Commissioner Skinner to allow the use of lights on the runway, but deny winter use of the runway. The motion died, due to lack of a second. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Crandall to allow the use of lights and winter use of the runway. The motion carried, with the vote being: Wassenberg - aye, Crandall - aye, Skinner - nay.

The County Clerk was directed to prepare a letter of support for the continued location of the Wyoming County Commissioners Association office in Cheyenne and its director, B.G. "Jerry" Michie.

The Board decided to pursue the location of scales closer to the Pinedale area. The Clerk was directed to send the letter to the District Engineer for the Department of Transportation.

The following petitions and affidavits for abatement of taxes were presented on petition from the County Assessor and the State of Wyoming Board of Equalization: William P. County Treasurer Nylla Kunard discussed the early repayment of large abatements of taxes. The Board directed the County Treasurer to continue to pay the rebates on a five year plan.


Suzanne Young, Democratic candidate for State Representative in District 22, visited with the Board.


