

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
DECEMBER 15, 1992

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Craig Crandall, Monte Skinner, Buzz Wassenberg, Stuart McKinley, Mike McGinnis, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The minutes of the preceding meeting of December 1, 1992, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner. The motion carried.

The official bond for Elaine Barlow, Treasurer for School District #1, in the amount of \$25,000, was approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

Tom Giles of Mountain Fuel presented gifts to the board.

Amy Reed, Director of Sublette Community Counseling Service, discussed staffing changes and reported on the agency's activities.

Representative Louie Tomassi discussed proposed legislation.

Adrienne Peterson, Sublette County Weed and Pest, discussed proposed legislation with the Board.

The Pinedale Preschool students sang Christmas carols for the Board and presented each with a hand-made ornament.

Mike McGinnis, Road and Bridge Superintendent, reported on his department's activities and winter plowing.

It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to adopt Resolution No. 92-377C to vacate part of Big Piney Dump Ground County Road No. 23-182, combine Big Piney Dump Ground County Road No. 23-182 and Big Piney Dump Ground - Costello County Road No. 23-182-1, and name the roadway Frontier Lane County Road No. 23-182A. The motion carried.

In accordance with the public notice published in the Pinedale Roundup on November 26, 1992, public hearing was held for the following:

1. It was moved by Commissioner Skinner and seconded by Commissioner Wassenberg to accept and act upon the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission. Upon vote, the motion carried and the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF ENRON OIL AND GAS COMPANY TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 5.0 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM A-1 DISTRICT TO I-L DISTRICT, BEING PART OF THE NW&NW& OF TRACT 41, SECTION 20, T28N, R113W.

The accompanying lot division plat was signed by the Board.

2. It was moved by Commissioner Skinner and seconded by Commissioner Wassenberg to accept and act upon the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission. Upon vote, the motion carried and the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF JACK FRENCH TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 1.629 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM A-1 DISTRICT TO R-R DISTRICT, BEING PART OF THE SE&NW& OF SECTION 34, T34N, R109W.

3. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to accept and act upon the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission. Upon vote, the motion carried and the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF PHIL MARINCIC TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 10.0 ACRES, FROM A-1 DISTRICT TO R-R 10 DISTRICT, BEING PART OF LOT 7 (NE&NE&) OF SECTION 15, T30N, R110W.

4. It was moved by Commissioner Skinner and seconded by Commissioner Wassenberg to accept and act upon the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission. Upon vote, the motion carried and the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF JAMES T. AND MARGARET A. NOBLE TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 28.5 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM A-1 DISTRICT TO R-R 5 DISTRICT, BEING THE NW&NW& OF SECTION 10, T34N, R110W OR MORE SPECIFICALLY LOT 2; LOT 3; LOT 4; LOT 5 AND LOT 6 OF THE CONCEPTUAL PLAN FOR THE PROPOSED NOBLE SUBDIVISION AS SUBMITTED.

It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to approve the Leipnik Lot Division plat. The motion carried and the plat was signed.

John Mortenson of Mortenson, Stevens & Co. PC, presented the FY92 audit. It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner Skinner to accept the audit report. The motion carried. The County Clerk was directed to notify the appropriate boards and departments of the deficiencies noted in the management letter.
