OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
DECEMBER 6, 1994

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Monte Skinner, Buzz Wassenberg, Stuart McKinley, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The minutes of the preceding meeting of November 15, 1994, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner McKinley. The motion carried.

The official bonds for Donald D. Pope as Secretary-Treasurer for the Sublette County Rural Health Care District, in the amount of \$5,000; and Gary Wilson, Treasurer for the Sublette County Museum Board, in the amount of \$1500, were approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

Sealed bids were opened for the plowing of Skyline Drive for the 94-95 season. Four bids were received. After review, it was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to award the bid to Cora Valley Construction in the amount of \$55 per hour. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Wassenberg and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to adopt Resolution No. 94-444S accepting the alteration of the Willow Lake County Road No. 23-119 in Sections 22, 27, 28, and 33, T34N, R109W. The motion carried. The Board signed the plat.
