OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
AUGUST 6, 1996

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Buzz Wassenberg, Stuart McKinley, Bill Cramer, Jim Hutchinson, Dave Trombly, Janet Montgomery of the Pinedale Roundup, Mike McGinnis, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The minutes of the budget hearing of July 15, 1996, and the preceding regular meeting of July 16, 1996, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner McKinley and seconded by Commissioner Cramer. The motion carried.

The official bond was approved for Dave Racich, Secretary/Treasurer for the Sublette County Rural Health Care District, in the amount of \$5,000, was approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

In accordance with the public notice published in the Pinedale Roundup on August 1, 1996, public hearing was held for the transfer of funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 from Depreciation Reserve to the Library. Action on the transfer was tabled until later in the day, and at that time, the transfer was denied.

Carl Detwyler of Carney Architects, presented the four bids for the Pinedale Ambulance Barn Addition, which were opened on August 2, 1996. After review of the bids and the project funding, it was moved by Commissioner Cramer and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to provide the additional funds to fund the project and the architect's fees. The motion carried, with the vote being Cramer-aye, McKinley-aye, and Wassenberg-nay. It was moved by Commissioner Cramer and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to award the bid to A. Pleasant Construction for the amount of \$85,100.00, with architect's fee to be 10% or \$8,510. The motion carried, with the vote being Cramer-aye, McKinley-aye, and Wassenberg-nay.

At the request of Judy Adler, Hoback Ranches Service and Improvement District Director, and in accordance with W.S. 18-12-112(d), it was moved by Commissioner Cramer and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to proclaim the district's election. The motion carried.
