Commissioner Cramer presented a brochure from the Wyoming Citizens for Property Tax Reform.

Dave Simonsen of Wyoming Machinery, presented the contract for a 938F Caterpillar wheel loader for the Marbleton Landfill to be signed, which the Board signed.

Lee Lev, Paul Fovel, Sandy McCrary, and Willis Meeks all residents provided access by Merna-North Beaver County Road No. 23-115, inquired about snow plowing for the upcoming winter. The Board assured them that it intended to plow the road and would only quit, if the snow conditions were severe. The Board, also, would provide notification, if it decided to stop plowing.

Eric Peterson, Extension Agent, inquired about the use of office space in the basement of the Law Enforcement Building for a University of Wyoming funded staff person. It was noted that the office occupied by the Public Defender has been used for storage since May. The Board directed that Keith Goody be invited to the next meeting to discuss the situation, and the Board will continue to pursue space for the extension person.

Susan Giannettino, Leanne McClain, and Fred Wuthrick, representing the Sublette Citizens for Recycling, informed the Board that since the Town of Pinedale is exchanging property with Rusty Gooch, their current location will no longer be available. They requested the use of the Walker Building, which currently houses the Food Basket and six other entities. Commissioner Wassenberg stated his opposition to the request. Commissioner Cramer suggested parking the county vehicles outside to accommodate recycling and offering to provide parking for Gooch's tree spade until another location could be secured.

Kent Sojourner presented a proposal for the installation of a Duro-Last Roofing system at the Law Enforcement building for the amount of \$42,650.00. The installation would include removing the existing roof, replacing the skylight, replacing any saturated insulation, and installation of drainages. It was moved by Commissioner Cramer and seconded by Commissioner McKinley to accept the proposal, upon the review of the Deputy County Attorney and the County Clerk. The motion carried.

The Board recessed to travel to Mark Jones' property to discuss the road.

It was moved by Commissioner McKinley and seconded by Commissioner Cramer to adopt Resolutions 96-515W and 96-516W approving the applications by the Pinedale Fire Department and Boulder Fire Department to the Farm Loan Board for 2 One Ton 4x4 trucks. The motion carried.
