OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
NOVEMBER 18, 1997

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Buzz Wassenberg, Gordon Johnston, Jim Hutchinson, Dave Trombly, Deputy County Attorney Ed Wood, Cat Urbigkit of the Pinedale Roundup, Mike McGinnis, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present. Commissioner Bill Cramer was absent.

The minutes of the preceding meeting of November 4, 1997, were ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Johnston and seconded by Chairman Wassenberg. The motion carried.

The official bonds for Tracey Hoover, Treasurer for the Firefighters Association of Sublette County, in the amount of \$50,000, and Tracey Hoover, Bookkeeper for the Recreation Board of Sublette County, in the amount of \$5,000, were approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

The Board reviewed the contract with Rod Bennett for the road construction on Mark Jones' property and approved the delay of the construction until spring. The Board directed McGinnis to plow snow through the Jones' property this winter.

Mike McGinnis, Road and Bridge Superintendent, reported on hauling gravel, presented a traffic study on Daniel-Merna County Road No. 23-112, which the Board referred to Ed Wood for a resolution, and chip-sealing and crack-sealing of paved county roads.

The Board directed McGinnis to prepare specifications for the Peterson Hill project for a spring bid.

It was reported that Commissioners Cramer and Johnston had viewed the proposed access at the Dave Goodwin property and that a solution was approved.

It was moved by Commissioner Johnston and seconded by Chairman Wassenberg to appoint Shari Pape, Deputy County Clerk, to the County Canvass Board. The motion carried.

Commissioner Johnston discussed the remodeling at the Pinedale Clinic and will contact the Rural Health Care District about vacating the office space for Keith Raney, County Sanitarian.

Sheriff Hank Ruland and Undersheriff Henry Schmidt discussed the two-hour parking area in front of the Courthouse and will contact the Town of Pinedale to determine if the signs can be removed. Ruland reported that multiple juvenile drug arrests had been made in Pinedale last week, and that the storage building at the County Shop is almost complete. The Board requested that speed patrol on certain county roads.

The Board inspected the new county van.
