

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 7, 1999

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session for the purpose of FY00 budget preparation on this date at 9:15 a.m. with Bill Cramer, Gordon Johnston, Betty Fear, Cat Urbigkit of the Pinedale Roundup, Rob Shaul of the Sublette County Journal, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The Board met with Scott Thompson, Emergency Management Coordinator, to consider his budget request of \$98,760.00. After discussing the duties of the department, the Board decided to reschedule Thompson, and took no action on his request.

The Board met with Mike McGinnis, Road and Bridge Superintendent, and discussed the cost of surfacing Stone Trail and Granite Lane. After reviewing cost estimates for three different surface applications, the Board decided to include \$68,517 for inverted pen for Stone Trail and Granite Lane, and \$25,000 for the repairs to Club House Lane in the tentative budget.

The Board met with Don Brewer, County Coroner, and reviewed requests for salary increases for his position and his deputies. After discussion of the deputies' salaries and compensation for calls, the Board requested a recommendation from Brewer concerning calls, before tentatively approving his budget request.

The Board met with Sheriff Hank Ruland and Undersheriff Henry Schmidt on the Detention, Communications, and Law Enforcement budget requests.

County Coroner Don Brewer presented a letter of resignation. It was moved by Commissioner Fear and seconded by Commissioner Johnston to accept the resignation. The motion carried. The Board directed the County Clerk to notify the Republican Party of the vacancy.

The Board gave tentative approval to the following General Fund budget requests:
