

Bob Reese, District Ranger, reported on vegetation projects, prescribed burns, road construction and reconstruction, grazing, and the Lakeside Lodge master plan. Commissioner Cramer informed Reese that the Board had discussed Wilderness access for Search and Rescue with the Sheriff.

Reese reported that he had received the proposal from the County for maintenance of the Boulder Lake Road, and that no action or decision has been made.

Kelly Crane, Randy Weigel, and Eric Peterson, representing the University of Wyoming Cooperative Extension Service, presented the draft strategic plan for restructuring the Cooperative Extension Service. Strategic initiatives with regional services are proposed. Implementation is anticipated to begin in October, and will take 4-5 years to complete.

Brad Waters of Providence Associates, Inc., and Frank Grimes of Nelson Engineering, discussed the final draft of the master plan for the Courthouse Complex, and economies of time and construction. Nelson Engineering will provide engineering, survey, and soils analysis services.

The Board recessed into Executive Session to participate in a conference call with John McKinley of Davis and Cannon regarding ongoing litigation.

The Board reopened the meeting.

Commissioner Johnston reported on a memorandum of understanding for the Pinedale Anticline Transportation Committee.

Lance Koppenhafer, Kent Keller, and Gary Espenscheid discussed the Ag. Center scheduling and refunding, upcoming budget, and requested approval to purchase a sound system for the amount of \$4,195.00. Koppenhafer presented donations in the amount of \$4,500 to cover the cost of the system. It was moved by Commissioner Johnston and seconded by Commissioner Fear to approve the request for the installation and purchase of the system. The motion carried.

Doug Vickrey questioned the Ag. Center lean-to roof, bidding and purchase of accessories for the building, particularly the panels, and where the funding is available for the continued spending for this project.

The Board participated in a conference call with Paul Scherbel and John Erramouspe to discuss establishing a county road for access to their property. The Board referred the call to County Attorney Dale Aronson.
