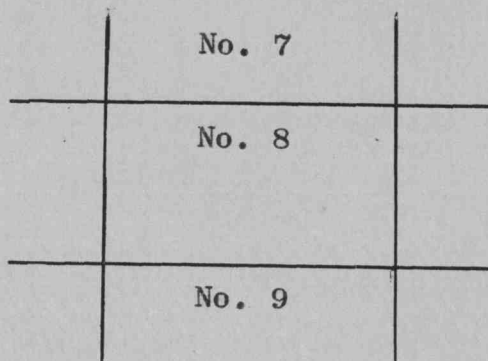
Beginning at a point which is 2110 feet in direction S.56°26'E. from NW corner section 4, T. 30 N., R. 104 W.,
