Medill, who are Citizens of the United States, did on the 10th day of October A.D., 1954, discover a quartz lode or vein bearing gold, silver, uranium and other valuable metals, with at least one well defined wall, to be known as the K.E.D. #1 Quartz Lode Mining Claim, and did on said day locate and claim by virtue of Chapter 6, of Title XXXII, of the Revised Statutes of the United States and laws of Wyoming
