THAT ON the 4th day of April, 1955, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is Rainbow # 21

THAT THE LOCATOR of this claim (is) (~~are~~) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.
