

## NOTICE AND CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION—LODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned

who is a Citizen of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization, hereby claim(s) the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim, under and pursuant to the Laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing his right thereto, hereby certify (certifies):

THAT ON the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1955, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is Rainbow 44

THAT THE LOCATOR of this claim (is) (~~are~~) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a location notice copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 1490 feet in a southeast direction and 10 feet in a northwest direction and in width, 590 feet in a northeast direction and 10 feet in a southwest direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

THAT THE EXTERIOR boundaries of this location are distinctly marked by posts or monuments at each corner and its boundaries can be readily traced, viz:

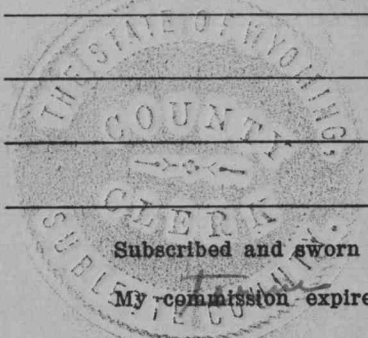
