The undersigned, Claud D. Fike, Don G. Fike, Merritt Hopkins, whose address is Riverton, Wyoming, hereby claims the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim, under and pursuant to the Laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing his right thereto, he hereby certifies:

1. CITIZENSHIP: That we (is) (are) a citizen of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization.

2. DISCOVERY: That on the 20 day of July, 1955, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

3. NAME: The name of this claim is Dolly No. 10

4. LOCATOR: The Locators of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

5. EXTENT OF CLAIM: The extent of this claim, hereby claimed by the said Locators, is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 1050 feet in a west direction and 450 feet in a easterly direction, and, in width, 30 feet in a northerly direction and 300 feet in a southerly direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

6.
