KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned, Wanda B. Stubbs, Opha E. Fike, Don G. Fike, whose address is Riverton, Wyoming, hereby claims the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim, under and pursuant to the Laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing his right thereto, he hereby certifies:

1. CITIZENSHIP: That we (is) (are) a citizens of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization.

2. DISCOVERY: That on the 16 day of July, 1955, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

3. NAME: The name of this claim is Dame No. 12.

4. LOCATOR: The Locators of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

5. EXTENT OF CLAIM: The extent of this claim, hereby claimed by the said Locators, is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 750 feet in a easterly direction and 750 feet in a westerly direction, and, in width, 300 feet in a northerly direction and 300 feet in a southerly direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

6. DESCRIPTION: The description of this claim, and the boundaries thereof, is as follows: Commencing at the point of discovery, at which a copy of this Certificate was posted, which point bears 750' west from the center of the west end line, thence 750' east to the said center of the east end line, the point of beginning; thence 300' south to Corner No. 1; thence 1500' west to Corner No. 2; thence 600' north to Corner No. 3; thence 1500' east to Corner No. 4; thence 300' south to the point of beginning.
