

LOCATION CERTIFICATE AND NOTICE — LODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That

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citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, having discovered a mineral lead, lode, ledge, or vein, of quartz or other rock in place, or deposit, containing valuable minerals therein, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all Uranium, Phosphate, Chromium and
associated minerals in limestone sandstone & phosphate rock
under, and in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of Wyoming, eight hundred
feet horizontally along the vein or lode thereof, measured 750 feet southward and 750 feet
northeast from the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, and 300 feet in width
on each side of the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, together with all dips, spurs, angles,
variations, veins, leads, lodes, ledges and deposits. Said claim is situated in Unknown

Stone Monument is E 11° S approx of W. cor of Lower O. River Lake. Monument is E 46° N approx of BM 11605 on Sheep Mtn. Slide into Lower Lake out Lakes West side is approx West 45° South of Monument. Decker's new house is approx W. 31° North. As measured on U.S.S. Fremont Peak Quad. 1906, stream entrance on W. side of Lower lake about a mile from north end of lake would be about 3/4 mile S.W. of Monument. Point ~~at~~ ^A on Little Sheep would be W 16° N of Monument.

On the surface at the point of discovery a plain notice has been posted containing the name of the lode or claim, the name-----of the discoverer-----and locator-----, and the date of such discovery. The surface boundaries of said claim have been marked upon the ground with substantial monuments in the following manner, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 220 feet Northwesterly of the Discovery Monument and running

thence Northwesterly six hundred feet to the Northwesterly corner monument;
thence Southerly by P¹⁰W 750 feet to the Northwesterly side center monument;
thence 220 feet Southerly feet to the place of beginning.
