That he is Adolph Kopp Jr. of Swan Lake, Montana a citizen of USA and discoverer  
of Lucky Strike number one lode claim situated in the Sublette

; that on the 26 day of August, 19 55, Adolph Kopp Jr. Vernon Lawrence Dwight Hogue  
performed the discovery work on said lode claim by posting limits of claims with plain wooden

an adjacent area of several thousand square feet.

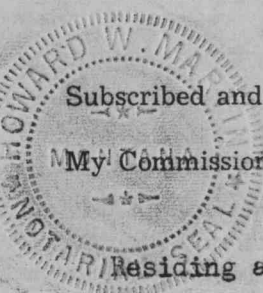
which discovery work is located Approx. seventy-five yards north westward

Section 57-914, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, reads: "A description of the claim by such designation of natural or fixed object, or if upon ground surveyed by the United States system of land survey, by reference to section or quarter section corners, as shall identify the claim beyond question."

Section 57-917, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended, "The drilling of such hole, or holes, or the sinking of the shaft or making of the discovery pit otherwise provided for in this Act shall be made a matter of record by the recording in the office of the County Clerk of the county in which the claim shall be situated the affidavit or sworn statement of the discoverer, locator, owner or his or their agents stating the date of such work, the nature thereof, the person or persons by whom performed, the location of such work within the claim, and the nature of the mineral discovered. Such affidavit may be a part of the location certificate to be thereafter recorded in accordance with the provisions of this Act."
