THAT ON the 1st day of Sept., 1955, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of Uranium, Copper, Gold, Silver, Iron, and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is Elkhorn Rim # 2

THAT THE LOCATORS of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 1500 feet in a North direction and 1500 feet in a South direction and in width, 600 feet in a East direction and 600 feet in a West direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.
