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No. 13272 CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF "THE SPRING VALLEY OIL CO."
 Certificate of Incorporation of "The Spring Valley Oil Co."

We, Whose names are hereunto subscribed, and to a duplicate hereof, desiring to form a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Wyoming, for the purposes herein-after specified, do hereby certify:

I.

That the corporate name of the said company shall be: "The Spring Valley Oil Company."

II.

That the objects for which said corporation is formed are as follow s: The acquisition by entry, purchase, lease or otherwise of claim, mines, mineral lands or other lands, and the prospecting for and the opening, development and operation of petroleum oil or other carbon-iferous oil or mineral mines, or of any manner of mines whatsoever upon any and all plans or systems, including the establishment of any plant or plants necessary or proper to be used in connection with such mining: The establishment and operation of any refineries, mills, factor-ies, stamping works, smelters or other plants, of whatsoever kind or character, for the rec-tifying, refining, reducing, milling, smelting or working any oils or mineral ores mined or produced by the said corporation, or the rectifying, refining, reducing, milling, smelting or working any oils or mineral ores of other persons or corporations, for profit: The establish-ment and operation of all hydraulic works necessary or proper to be used in connection there-with, and the acquisition by purchase, entry, lease, filings or otherwise, of all water or water rights necessary or proper to be used therefor or in connection therewith, and in gener-al to do all things necessary or incidental to the proper carrying on of the business of said company.

III.

The amount of the capital stock of the said corporation shall be Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00).

IV.

The number of shares of which said capital stock shall consist shall be Three Million (3,000,000) of a par value of ten cents (10c) each.

V.

The term of the existance of this corporation shall be fifty years.

VI.

VII.

The name of the town in which the operations of said corporation shall be carried on is Rock Springs, Sweetwater County, State of Wyoming, and at any other place or places within said State or otherwise where it may be deemed advisable to conduct any branch or branches of its business, or to have an office for the said company. The name of the town and county in which the principal part of the business of the company within the State of Wyoming it to be transacted is the town of Rock Springs, County of Sweetwater, in the State of Wyoming.

VIII.

The trustees of said corporation shall have power to make by laws as they shall deem proper for the management and disposition of the stock and business affairs of the corporation not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Wyoming, and prescribing the duties of all officers, artificers and servants that may be employed and for the appointment of all officers and for the carrying on of all kinds of business within the objects and purposes of the cor-poration.

IX.

The place where any and all suits against said corporation must be brought is an shall be the County of Sweetwater and State of Wyoming.
