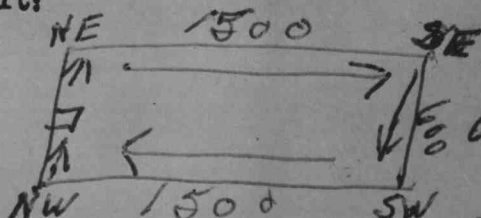

## LOCATION NOTICE -- LODE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

George S. Smith  
 citizen S of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years and residing in  
 the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, having  
 discovered a vein or lode of quartz, or rock in place, bearing molysdenum & all other  
 within the claim hereby located, claim by right of discovery and location, under and  
 in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States Chapter 2, Title 30, Mineral  
 and amendments thereto, and the laws of the State of Wyoming 1500 feet  
 linear and horizontal measurement along the vein or lode thereof, with all its dips,  
 variations and angles, together with 300 feet in width on each side of  
 the center of the discovery shaft, or discovery workings; and all veins, lodes, uranium  
 ledges, deposits and surface grounds within the lines of said claims and within the  
 operation and affect of said U. S. Revised Statutes and Wyoming Statutes. Said claim  
 is situated in Unorganized Mining District, County of Sublette  
 and State of Wyoming, and is bounded and more particularly described as follows,
