 citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years and residing in the County of *Sublette* and State of *Wyoming*, having discovered a vein or lode of quartz, or rock in place, bearing *NE 1/4* and *SW 1/4* within the claim hereby located, claim by right of discovery and location, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States Chapter 2, Title 30, and amendments thereto, and the laws of the State of Wyoming *1500* feet linear and horizontal measurement along the vein or lode thereof, with all its dips, variations and angles, together with *300* feet in width on each side of the center of the discovery shaft, or discovery workings; and all veins, lodes, ledges, deposits and surface grounds within the lines of said claims and within the operation and affect of said U. S. Revised Statutes and Wyoming Statutes.
