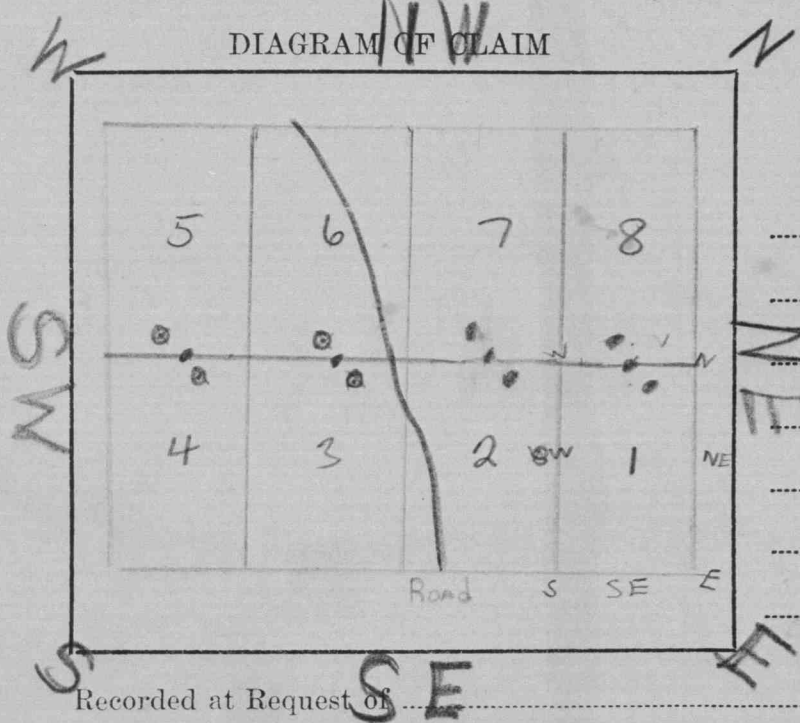
Angles and Variations T 29 N, R 103 W, in W 1/2 and NE 1/4 of section 15
