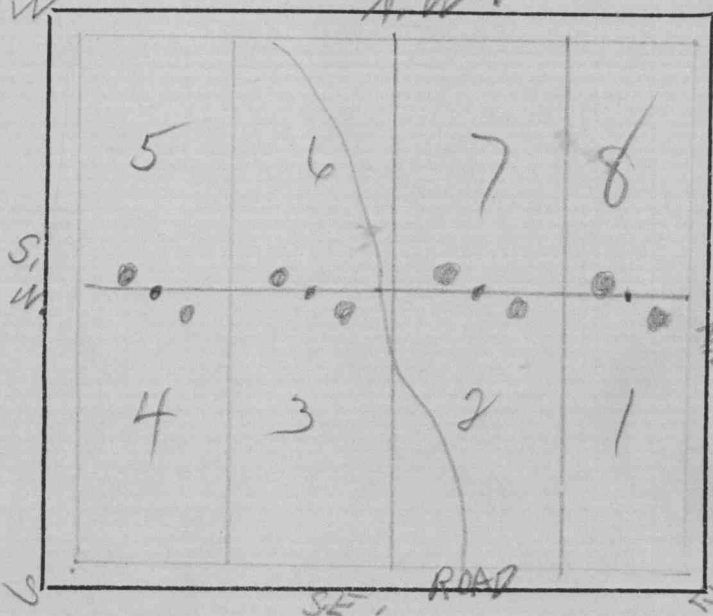
in the UNKNOWN Mining District,
