

LOCATION CERTIFICATE AND NOTICE — LODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That Clayton Gaddes, who is a

citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, having discovered a mineral lead, lode, ledge, or vein, of quartz or other rock in place, or deposit, containing valuable minerals therein, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all Gold, Silver, Nickel, Cobalt, Lithium and all other metals and minerals

under, and in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of Wyoming, 1500 feet horizontally along the vein or lode thereof, measured 750 feet East and 750 feet West from the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, and 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, together with all dips, spurs, angles, variations, veins, leads, lodes, ledges and deposits. 
