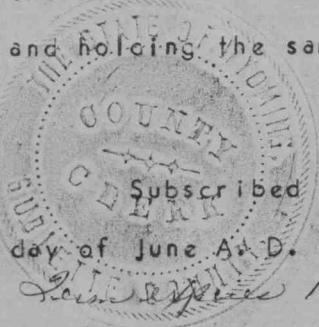

in work and expenditures has been done on the following described uranium,
thorium mining claims situate in the ----- mining district, in the
County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, to-wit;

C and C #1; Beginning at the NW Corner of Section 6, Township 32N,
Range 107W, thence S 39°, 48' E, 563' to Corner #1 of the C and C
#1 Claim, the pt of beginning of this survey; thence S 7°- 39W
1500' to Corner of #2, thence N 80° 21W, 600' to Corner #3,
thence N 7°-39' E 1500' to Corner #4, thence S 80°, 21' E, 600'
back to Corner #1, the pt of beginning.

C and C #2; Beginning at the NW Corner of Section 6, Township 32N,
Range 107W, thence S 39°- 48' E, 563' to Corner #1 of the C and C
#2 Claim, the pt of beginning of this survey; thence S 80°-21' E
600' to Corner #2; thence S 7°- 39' W, 1500' to Corner #3; thence
N 80°-21' W, 600' to Corner #4; thence N 7°- 39' E, 1500' back
to Corner #1, the pt of beginning.
