

LOCATION CERTIFICATE AND NOTICE — LODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That Clayton Gaddes and A. R. Sonnek, who are

citizens of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, having discovered a mineral lead, lode, ledge, or vein, of quartz or other rock in place, or deposit, containing valuable minerals therein, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all gold, silver and all other minerals

under, and in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of Wyoming, 600 feet horizontally along the vein or lode thereof, measured 300 feet East and 300 feet West from the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, and 750 feet in width on each side of the center of the discovery shaft or discovery workings, together with all dips, spurs, angles, variations, veins, leads, lodes, ledges and deposits. Said claim is situated in Sublette Mining District in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, in the

Little Twin Creek area, located in Section 31, Township 38 North, Range 110 West.

more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
 Beginning at a point which is the Forks of the Little Twin Creek, thence ~~West~~ 1200 feet, thence North 1500 feet to Corner No. 1, which is the Southwest Corner of this claim, thence North 1500 feet to Corner No. 2, which is the Northwest Corner of this claim, thence East 600 feet to Corner No. 3, which is the Northeast Corner of this claim, thence South 1500 feet to Corner No. 4, which is the Southeast Corner of the claim, thence West 600 feet, thence South 1500 feet, thence East 1200 feet to the point of beginning.
