

## LOCATION CERTIFICATE AND NOTICE — LODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That JAMES COLLINS, TRAVIS HENDRICKS,

SW RESPECTIVELY) TO CORNER No. 1 WHICH IS THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THIS CLAIM, THENCE 1500 FT. TO CORNER No. 2 WHICH IS THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THIS CLAIM, THENCE 600 FT. TO CORNER No. 3 WHICH IS THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THIS CLAIM, THENCE 600 FT. TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
