POWER OF ATTORNEY  
BENJIMAN PEARSON TO HENRY E. PEARSON

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I Benjiman Pearson a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Henry E. Pearson my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, to locate stake and record for me, mining claims, lode claims and placer mining claims, in the State of Wyoming and in the State of Utah, and having located the same, to grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and convey the same to such persons as my said attorney may desire; and also giving and granting unto my said Attorney full power and authority for me and in my name, place and stead to frant, bargain, sell and convey any and all mining claims, be they placer or lode claims, which have heretofore or shall hereafter be located in my name in the States of Wyoming and Utah, and in my name and as my act and deed to sign, seal acknowledge and deliver deeds and conveyances for the same to such persons as my said Attorney may desire, hereby giving and granting unto my said Attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite to be done in the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.
